The exam session will be held Saturday November 29th. Pre-registration is strongly recommended. The session opens at 2:30 PM. Walk-ins will be accepted until 3:00pm, and testing will begin at 3:05pm.

Items needed to participate in test session:

1. Need 2 forms of ID, one that has to be a picture ID.
2. If upgrading then a current Amateur Radio License or a CSCE certification certificate.
3. Two copies of ID's, License, and / or CSCE.
4. \$14.00 (the correct amount please), this fee is charged once, no matter whether taking one, two, three or all three test elements, one time. Retests of an element failed at the same test session will require payment of an additional test fee.
5. No programmable calculators, ipods, or PDAs
6. Pencils preferred for test. Pens needed to sign forms.
